



Because of the late end of the school year and the teacher work days that follow, the Summer Options school program has shifted its start and end dates as well. **The K - 8 summer school will start on Tuesday, July 7, and run for four weeks to Friday, July 31. The high school program will start on Wednesday, July 1, and run for six weeks to Friday, August 7.** Classes for preschooler grade 1 will be located at **Whiting Lane Elementary School**, and classes for grades 2 - 8 will be held this year at **King Philip Middle School**. The high school program will be at **Conard High School**, and the school days for just that program will run slightly longer to accommodate the reduced number of school days.

Our summer programs continue to offer the best value among area programs for your child. Summer Options for Kids is a morning program of academics, arts, and just plain fun courses for children from pre-kindergarten through eighth grade. The program day runs from 8:30 AM to 11:30 AM, allowing for up to four different course selections for students in grades 2 - 8. The high school program is open to students completing grades 8 - 12 and offers more than 50 courses for credit and personal enrichment.

Bus transportation is also provided for students living the required distances from the program schools, and this year the bus routes will be streamlined for even more timely service!
