



Step 2: Evening Orientation at School

Parents/guardians only

- 1. Meet school staff and fellow parents/guardians
- 2. Take a tour of the school
- Receive paperwork to complete & bring back on Registration Day
- 4. Sign-up for time to visit with your child on Registration Day

Step 3: Kindergarten Registration/Visit Day

- You and your child
- During school day
- Bring your registration materials

e-registration

- 1. Follow the link on the website or card. Provide basic information. 2-3 business days turn around
- 2. Receive and email with full registration materials electronically
- 3. Proof of Residency Documents- you have choice.
 - You can scan them (must be readable) or bring them in person.
 - Bring to residency office or on visiting day this spring. (you or a relative)

In your folder there is a card with link and QR code

4. **Parent Portal is open!** Access to other important paperwork and information.


